*Very fresh, expressive fragrances of citrus, apricots and grapefruit. A lovely balance of fruits on the palate with mineral, flinty notes*

**Sancerre Domaine Vincent Gaudry, Loire** **£29.95**

### **Tapaga Verdejo, Castilla Y Leon**

**£14.95**

*This light, fresh and clean white explores delicious white fruits such as apples, grapefruit and pears. Beautifully balanced (Also available by the glass)*

### **Saigoba Rioja Blanco**

**£15.95**

*Clean and soft, packed with pear, lime and lemon fruit leaving an uplifting and delicate mouthfeel*

### **Pinhal da Torre, Ferno Pires, Ribatejo**

**£16.95**

*Clean, clear and seamless, peach greengage and green apricot fruit, charming and seductive with hints of jasmine and white flower

### **Viura Sonsierra Blanco**

**£17.95**

*This is an unoaked white Rioja. Crisp, dry and fresh – this wine is good with salads, fish and white meats*

### **Verdejo Blanco Ossian, Castilla Y Leon**

*A delicate, aromatic Verdejo made by Spain's top white producer in the hills of Castilla Y Leon - just off dry with lemony notes*

### **Bacalhoa Caterina, Ferno Pires/Chardonnay, Azeitão**

**£22.95**

*Notes of yellow fruits, such as peach and pineapple, combined with subtle nuances of toasted wood, presenting a firm finish, which is very fresh, mineral, long and complex*

### **Clos Montblanc Chardonnay**

**£23.95**

*Big, barrel fermented Chardonnay from the Conca de Barbera region just south of Barcelona*

### **Quinta do Portal Blanco**

**£24.95**

*Very interesting dry and fruity white from the Terra Alta region which is up in the high ground behind Tarragona. Garnacha Blanco is the predominant grape variety*

### **Albariño Gran bazan Verde**

**£26.95**

*From Rias Baixas, Galicia in north-west Spain – this refreshing dry white is brilliant with fish and seafood*

### **Albarino Gran bazan Limousin**

**£39.95**

*Albarino which has spent 6 months ageing in oak barrels to give it a very complex, rich but dry flavour. Gran Bazan was the first producer to experiment with this style*

### **Long Beach Chenin Blanc, Robertson, South Africa**

**£14.95**

*This fantastic Cape Chenin has aromas of melon and ripe green fig with a citrus palate bursting with tropical fruit flavours and a long fine creamy finish (Also available by the glass)*

### **Torrentes, Finca La Florencia, Familia Cassone, Argentina**

**£18.95**

*A varietal of bright yellow colour and touches of green tints, it is delicate and has intense aromas of tropical flowers and fruits, it is also very fresh and well balanced with a round and persistent palate*

### **Cousiño Macul Chardonnay, Maipo Valley, Chile**

**£18.95**

*Bright yellow with rich tropical fruit aromas with caramel and honey notes (Also available by the glass)*

### **Pinot Grigio San Simone, Grave Del Friuli, Italy**

**£18.95**

*The complex character and mouth-watering, soft white fruits give this wine great balance and freshness, excellent with salads and white meats (Also available by the glass)*

### **Little Beauty Sauvignon Blanc, Waihopai Valley, Marlborough NZ**

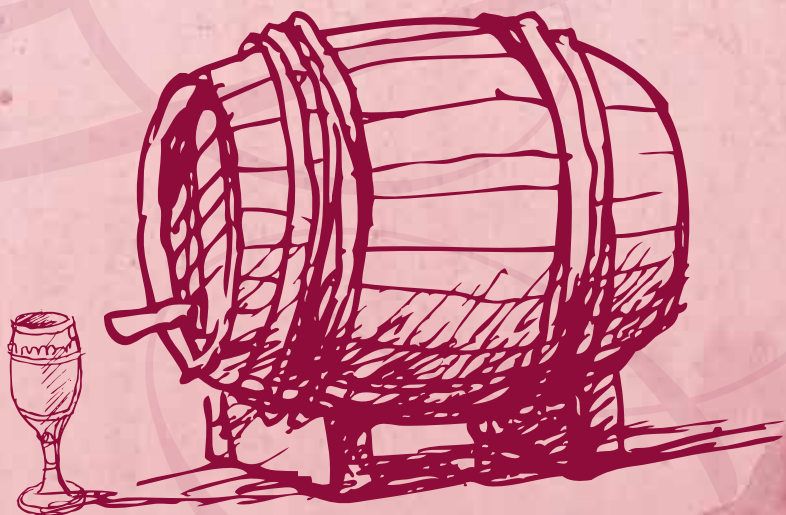

### **Donnafugata Polena Viognier/Cattaratto, Marsala, Italy**

**£29.95**

*Very clean nose, with notes of lime and tropical fruit along with delicate mineral nuances. On the palate, it is rich and tropical, with peach and apricot characters lifted by a lovely freshness which lasts to the finish*

**Domaine Montrose cabernet/Syrah, Languedoc** £14.95

*Delicious juicy ripe red and black berry flavours with bramble, cedar, chocolate and white pepper (Also available by the glass)*

**Domaine de la Chique, Grenache/Carignan/Syrah, Cotes du Roussillon** £18.95

*Lively, refreshing and fruity with warm spiced mulberry, sloe and liquorice, surprisingly lifted and vivid with bright red cherries*

**Cotes de Ventoux, Rhone** £19.95

*The wine shows the full aromatic power of the two grapes varieties (Grenache/syrah) used for tits making, whilst retaining the freshness imparted by well-controlled winemaking (Also available by the glass)*

**Chateau Meaune, Bordeaux** £19.95

*Made from 80% Merlot, 10% Cab Franc and 10% Cab Sauv, this is beautifully rich in colour, smooth and full of soft fruits (Also available by the glass)*

**Côte de Brouilly, Domaine des Roches Bleues, Beaujolais, France** £22.95

*One of the top 10 Crus produced in Beaujolais, this is deep red in colour with a hint of violet and has a delightful bouquet of raspberries and blackcurrants and a touch of spice (Also available by the glass)*

**Cahors Cedre Heritage** £23.95

*Cahors is a very ancient wine producing region that was established long before Bordeaux. Situated between Bordeaux and Toulouse. It's the original home of the Malbec grape variety (also known as Auxerrois). It's full bodied and rich but the tannins are ripe and integrated. Heart warming but soft*

**Lirac, Rhone** £25.95

*A juicy and refreshing Grenache wine, invigorating, spicy and rich, bursting with plum, currant, liquorice spice, herb and cedar*

**Sancerre Rouge, Domaine de la Villaudiere, Loire** £26.95

*Made with Pinot Noir, this red from the Loire is delicate and soft with light cherry and spicy characters. Ideal match for those who want red wine with fish*

**Domaine Rimauresq Rouge, Cru Classé Côtes de Provence** £26.95

*An approachable red with a fruity nose that belies its soft, warm mouth feel and plummy fruit characters. A great assemblage of Syrah, Cab sauv, Carignan and Mouverdre*

**Clos Poggiale rouge, Vin de Pays de Corse** £29.95

*A blend of Sangiovese (locally known as Nielluccio) and Syrah grown on the east coast of Corsica. This is deep ruby red wine with an elegant perfume with notes of raspberry and sweet spices. The palate is vibrant with a fine fruit concentration and silky tannins, toasted character on the finish*

**Haute Cotes de Beaune, Bourgogne** £29.95

*Uncomplicated, wild, pure and juicy fruit, packed with vibrant raspberry, forest berry, redcurrant and red cherry flavours*

**Château Moulin La Graviere Lalande de Pomerol, Bordeaux** £39.95

*Offering much better value for money than Pomerol, this satellite appellation delivers the goods every time. Elegant but rich, it shows real maturity with hints of tobacco and leather whilst retaining the trademark plum and blackcurrant jam characters*

*Dark cherry and blackcurrant are lifted by a hint of dried flowers and sweet spice (Also available by the glass)*

**Epico Tempranillo, Castilla La Mancha** **£16.95**

*This medium bodied wine shows juicy acidity and bright raspberry fruit with lively notes of dusty earth, dry herbs and leather*

**Nova Soffra, Cab Sauv/Casteleo/Trincadeira/Touriga Nacional, Ribatejo** **£16.95**

*Smooth fine tannins, round plum, damson, salt and leather spice character; very svelte fruits with spice complexity (Also available by the glass)*

**Monastrell El Paso, Jumilla, Murcia** **£17.95**

*Bright, juicy fruit with the depth and power of old vines. Monastrell gives the blueberry fruit and aromas of leather and spice, while Syrah adds some floral top-notes. A full and rich wine (Also available by the glass)*

**Garnacha Finca, Castilla La Mancha** **£21.95**

*High aromatic intensity with initial hints of mineral, violets and ripe red berries. Notes of Indian ink and subtle nuances of new oak, tobacco and breadcrumbs. In the mouth, a silky attack, fresh with a velvety, full mouthfeel*

**Quinta do Alqueve Tradicionnal, Tinto Roriz/Casteleo/Trincadeira/Touriga Nacional, Ribatejo** **£21.95**

*Complex, smooth, smouldering berry flavours, fine grained spicy, crushed fruit, suprisingly powerful and gripping*

**Rioja Crianza, Lealtanza, Rioja Alta** **£23.95**

*A vivacious wine, full bodied with juicy red fruits and spicy characters, giving way to a long and elegant finish (Also available by the glass)*

**Mesoneros Ribera Del Duero** **£24.95**

*It is made also with Tempranillo, locally known as Tinto del Pais but the terroir is quite different hence the flavours are much more savoury, smokey and meaty orientated*

**Tinto Mas de Bazan, Bobal** **£26.95**

*Bobal is an indigenous grape variety which is grown widely only in Utiel Requena. Smooth and ripe – well worth trying – you won't be disappointed!*

**Tinto Mas de Bazan, Syrah** **£26.95**

*Powerful, flavoursome wine with bags of character! This can cope with the richest red meat dishes. The unique label is a copy of the tiles used in the winery*

**Bodegas Pittacum, Bierzo Tinto** **£28.95**

*The local, indigenous grape variety is Mencia. Packed with juicy cherry, liquorice and spicy notes, the finish is oregano and smoke*

**Almirez Toro, Tinto Da Toro, Teso La Monja** **£35.95**

*Floral and fresh cut flower aromas, notes of violet, cool, composed but bursting with bramble, blueberry and currant fruit*

**Pinhal Da torre Quinta do Alqueve, Touriga Nacional, Ribatejo** **£39.95**

*Seductive, smouldering fruit and spice nose, smooth palate, very fine and binding tannins, plum, blueberry and sweet spice*

### **Ochagavia Sylvester Merlot, Chile**

**£14.95**

*A straight forward new world merlot. Atypical of what it made in South America today. Packed with fruit which is sure to please everyone round the table (Also available by the glass)*

### **Primitivo, Spina di bacco, Salento Italy**

**£16.95**

*Primitivo is the original Zinfandel grape variety. Rich, heart warming with delicious bramble and peppery notes with hints dried herbs (Also available by the glass)*

### **Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve Maipo Valley Chile**

**£16.95**

*Packed with juicy cassis and black cherry characters, it is full bodied with ripe tannins and a light minty finish (Also available by the glass)*

### **Montepulciano D'Abbruzzo, classic, Italy**

**£24.95**

*Montepulciano, the grape variety, has been for years associated with mediocre wines sold in bad Italian restaurants; however, in this case it is made with very low yield and a quality orientated approach. Medium bodied, oozing of black cherry jam characters and oregano, dusty soft tannins*

### **Pinotage, Martin Meinert South Africa**

**£24.95**

*The emphasis is placed on fruit and gentle extraction to avoid harsh tannins while retaining Pinotage characteristics*

### **Little Beauty Pinot Noir, Wahopai Valley, Marlborough, NZ**

**£28.95**

*Juicy black cherry jam flavours are dominant with layers of light spices; this typical Pinot from New Zealand is delicate and elegant, medium bodied with soft tannins*

### **Nero D'Avola, Sicily, Italy**

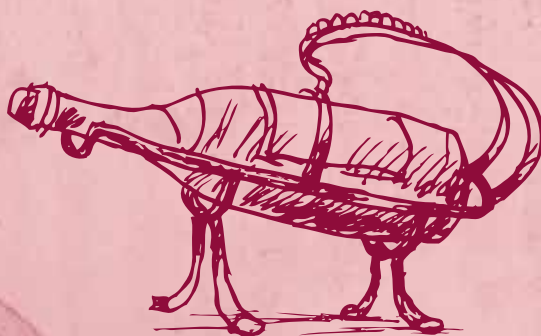
**£29.95**

*Deep ruby red in colour this wine is vibrant on the nose with black fruit, balsamic and mineral tones. Exuberant flavours of blackberries and sour cherries along with a touch of sweet cocoa on the palate*

*Easy to drink fruit driven rosé made with Tempranillo with a lovely spicy finish (Also available by the glass)*

### **Mas Juliette rose, Provence**

**£18.95**

*A delicious, feminine blend of Grenache, Cinsault and Ugni Blanc (white grape variety), this is made by a small producer in the Coteaux du Verdon, the Northern part of Provence. Very fresh, elegant with delicate raspberry notes (Also available by the glass)*

### **Chinon Rosé, Charles Joguet, Loire, France**

**£22.35**

*This Cabernet Franc Rosé is all about finesse and juicy, creamy fruit flavours which include touches of raspberry, strawberry and fresh cut herbs*

**£29.95**

*Deliciously sweet but yet really fresh, with citrus and spice aromas, and plenty of honey and tropical notes*

### **Banyuls Rimage "Les Clos de Paulilles", Roussillon (50cl)**

**£24.25**

*Very rich sweet fortified red wine with prune, mocha, caramel and herby flavours, absolutely superb with chocolate desserts or strong cheeses*
